(Moore College in Latin
America) – Distance
Learning Bible Course
Program (ThC)**

- > For the great privilege it is to be involved in this exciting ministry of the Word of God through the courses under MOCLAM and for the constant encouragement this involvement brings us.
- > For the great number of folk so enthusiastic about the courses, especially in Cuba. Give thanks for Carl from the UK, as he and his team and others provide funds and resources for the work on that island, and for Ray and his team, who head up the work there.
- > For all those studying the courses, that they will work hard at putting into practice what they learn from God's Word and grow to be more like Christ as they do so.
- > For all those who tutor the courses, that they will be diligent in their preparation and "live a life worthy of the Lord and please Him in every way".
- > For the team in MOCLAM: the Sholls, the Lovells and ourselves, that we will always make wise decisions that make for the best progress in MOCLAM as it serves the folk in the Spanish-speaking world. Pray for special wisdom for Peter as he heads up the team.
- > For Grahame as he continues to mark exams, as well as all of us involved in the formatting team, the course and book production line, that our priorities will always be ordered by the Lord.

* **TRAINING MORE TUTORS** over the next couple of years is our main aim.

This will be done primarily through...

* **INTENSIVE COURSES** which run over 1-2 weeks, with students doing one or two complete courses. MOCLAM in Cuba is planning 46 intensives (a total of 92 courses in all) this year all over the country. The University student work in Spain is taking on this method this year to train their staff workers.

* **CLASS STYLES:** ONLINE classes should increase as we refine our online site and work this year with tutors and students to give them confidence in using this method of study. FACE-TO-FACE classes will increase with the move to more intensives and the increase of tutors on the ground in Latin America, mostly missionaries and ex-students of the MOCLAM program.

* **EXAM MARKING** is an area of urgent need. We are working on training more people to mark exams to enable us to cope with the increase in the number of exams coming in. Training is already underway in Cuba.

* **TEXT BOOKS:** we plan to publish more of these books this year and hopefully print more of them inside Cuba as well; 2,000 copies of each of two texts for the courses we have published just came off the press over there last week.
